The beginning of a new year, among other things, means fresh opportunities to introduce our friends to Jesus Christ. Soon we'll be back at work and school, returning to old relationships and hopefully building some new ones. Helping someone come to Jesus Christ is the greatest gift you could ever give another person. Here's a tool that can help you. Consider inviting a friend to Christianity Explored (CE) or consider attending yourself.

What is CE?

Just like the name says, CE is a class that looks at what Christianity is all about. In particular it explores and answers the questions "Who is Jesus?" and "Why did he come?"

What is the class like?

We begin with a delicious dinner while sharing great conversation. Then we watch a short 10-minute video clip that introduces our topic, followed by some thought-provoking questions. Any and all questions are encouraged in our class. It is also suggested that you read the Gospel of Mark at home while the class goes on.

How long is it?

The class goes for seven consecutive weeks and each class takes less than two hours.

How big is the class?

It all depends on how many sign up, but we try to keep it small and cozy. 2-3 facilitators and 2-4 participants.

Do I need to bring anything?

No, just bring a healthy appetite, an open mind, and lots of questions.

Does it cost anything?

It doesn't cost a thing. It's free for all who are interested.

Where will it be held?

It's usually held in someone's home in a friendly and cozy environment. On the odd occasion, it's held at church.

Who should attend?

The class is open to people regardless of age, life stage, gender, race, faith (or not faith) background, but is primarily for those who are investigating Christianity and the friends that bring them.

When will it start?

We're planning on starting CE some time in March.

How can I help?
