1. Share what God has been teaching you from your Bible reading the past two weeks? If you like, follow the CUPS pattern: **C**hrist-centered, **U**se the bible, make it **P**ersonal, and keep it **S**hort.
2. What, from the sermon, stood out to you or made an impression on you? Share with your group.
3. There were 5-6 things in the sermon that described a Christian fanatic. Which one of them speaks most to you? Why? In what way does it challenge you to live a more 'fanatical' Christian life?
- 4a) How big of a portion is God to you? Share your honest answer. Do you want God to be a greater or larger portion in your life? Why or why not? Share your honest answer.

b) What is the danger of complacency when it comes to no longer wanting more of God in our lives?
5. Does it surprise you that Jesus was a radical, a revolutionary, and demanded that of his followers? Why do you think it is that we've domesticated Jesus to be so safe and tame? How might we have committed the sin of idolatry in doing so?
6. How is it that only the Gospel can give birth to greater passions and making God a greater portion in our lives? Ask God to reawaken our passions for Christ. Ask God to reawaken our first love for Jesus and to rekindle a fresh experience of the gospel in our lives. Spend time praying this for each other and for our church.
