"Praying to Our Creator"

(Psalm 119:73-80)

1. Go through week 27 of the New City Catechism (through your phone app, web browser (newcitycatechism.org), or book)
2. Read through Psalm 119:73-80 out loud as a group. Then, read it quietly to yourselves 1-2 times. Try to understand the main point of the passage. What do you think it is?
3. Every Christian on the planet acknowledges that God is the Creator. Why do you think this fact doesn't have the desired impact in our lives as it should? When coupled with God being our Redeemer/Saviour, how should these two truths impact every single, without exception, aspect of our lives? Specifically, how does knowing that God is your loving creator impact the way you think and act as a Christian?
4. What do you think about the phrase in vs. 75, "...in faithfulness you have afflicted me"? Has that been your confession?
5. What should we do if we have been angry with God?
6. How can the way we handle our suffering have a positive impact on others -- so powerfully that others begin praising God? Share an experience when you witnessed another believer's suffering that caused you to praise God.
7. Pray for one another and pray for yourself and pray for our church, that we would learn how to suffer well, and in our suffering, we would give glory to God.
