1. Please begin by going through the appropriate chapter (week 28/29) in your New City Catechism.
2. Read Psalm 119:81-88. What is the situation the psalmist is in? What words or phrases speak to this? What does he do to receive help in the situation he finds himself? What phrases and verses address this?
3. Have you ever been persecuted for your faith? Please describe. How did it make you feel?
4. What does persecution look like in Canada? Give examples.
5. Why should it not surprise us that Christians are persecuted? What does it say about us if we are never persecuted?
6. How can we better identify with and support those who are being persecuted?
7. Read their story together. In what way can the stories of those being persecuted strengthen our faith? How is does it give you more courage and boldness?
