
Life Group Sermon Based Questions

"The Eternal Word" (Psalm 119:89-96) Pastor Peter Yi July 16, 2017

1. Please begin your discussions by going through the appropriate week of the New City Catechism.
2. Read Psalm 119:89-96 together. Look for the natural divisions in the passage. Try to see the chiasmic structure:

- C Confessing the eternal word (89-91)
- B God's word helps us in our struggles (92)
- A Salvation for those who trust in the Word (93)
- A' Salvation for those who trust in the Word (94)
- B' God's word helps us in our struggles (95)
- C' Confessing the eternal word (96)

Are there any other observations or points that stick out for you? Share with your group.

3. Why are we often tempted as Christians to compromise our convictions that the Bible is in fact the Word of God and is true for all time and all ages? In what areas of the Bible's teaching have you compromised?
4. What could be the likely result of compromising our view on one part or one issue of the Bible? What will keep us from compromising on other parts? How will we determine which views to alter and which to keep the same?
5. How can you approach the Scriptures with more humility? What specifically does that look like to you?
6. Has your belief in the Bible as God's unchanging and eternal word led to you teaching it to others? Why or why not? How can you begin to make that more of a focus in your life?
7. The message of the Bible is how we can be saved. Four types of alienation resulted because of sin. What impact has sin made in your life and how does it keep us from being saved? How is the Gospel of Jesus Christ the answer to the sin problem? Give thanks for the Gospel, for the word and commit to treasure the word in your own life.
