1. Please begin your discussions by going through Question 30 of the New City Catechism. Read the question, the answer, and the commentary. Share your thoughts.
2. Read Galatians 6:7-10 together. Go around and share observation(s) or point(s) that stand out to you.
3. By what 2 points is Paul warning the churches of Galatia (and us) not to be deceived? Are there areas in your life where you have been, or could be, deceived?
4. What is the principle that Paul teaches? What does it mean? What illustration in the sermon was mentioned to better understand this principle?
5. What are the two different "fields" in which you can sow (Sowing to please the _____ vs. the _____)? Explain each. We are always sowing seeds (without thoughts, what we speak, and our actions). Where do you sow seeds in your life? How are you sowing in both "fields"? What is the result (harvest) of what you sow? Share with your group.
6. What does it mean to do good to all people (vs. 10)? How can you sow to please the Spirit in doing good to all people? Why does Paul urge us to do good to especially those who belong to the family of believers? What are some practical ways in which you can apply this?
7. Close your time together by making one application that you will practice throughout the week. Also, go around and share one thing (or more) that you're thankful to God for. Pray for each other.
