
Life Group Sermon Based Questions

"Seeing It God's Way, Part 2" (Psalm 119:121-128) Pastor Peter Yi August 27, 2017

Hello LG leaders,

Consider one or two of the leadership lessons from Saturday's STP and think of how you can begin putting it into practice.

1. Read through this week's New City Catechism w/ your group (#35).
2. Read Psalm 119:21-28. Take a few moments to quietly read and share the verse that speaks to you.
3. When you are going through a tough time, what is your means of dealing with it? Do you use one of the things that were mentioned at the beginning of the sermon? How has it worked or not worked for you?
4. Of the five points that were given in the sermon, which of them is most relevant to you at this time in your life?
5. Why is it so dangerous to use suffering as an excuse or opportunity to sin and rebel against God? What should we do instead? Be specific in sharing what that will look like in your life.
6. What does it mean to trust in the sovereignty of God? How does having a solid understanding of God's sovereignty help us in our trials? How has it helped you personally?
7. There were 12 things mentioned that suffering is meant to teach us. Pick one or two that you have personally experienced and share with your group.
8. How can the church be the place where we can carry each other's burdens, but also show a lost world, the love of Christ manifested in Christian community? For example, think of a non-Christian friend you know is suffering. How can the church be of help to them?
9. Consider the world we live in. Think of some of the current events that are examples of human suffering. Spend time in prayer for our world, and for the church to take the Gospel to a hurting world.
