## **Life Group Sermon Based Questions**

### **"Is the Bible Always Right?"**

**(Psalm 119:137-144)**

1. Please begin by going through the New City Catechism together. You should be on week 40. Go around and read through the commentary and then read the prayer at the end together.
2. Read through the text: Psalm 119:137-144. What do you learn about the word "Righteousness"? Share your discoveries w/ your group.
3. What is your personal experience with "relativism" in our society, on the campus, in the workplace, in pop culture?" Do you think relativism is a position that is consistent and one that we can fairly live with? If so, why? If not, why not?
4. Why is it impossible to have any morality without an absolute and unchanging morality?
5. What does it mean that God is righteous? What does it mean that he is the straight line, the norm, the standard?
6. Are you a soft-relativist? In what area(s) of morality are you a soft-relativist? Now, what is the problem with trying to live out soft-relativism?
7. Why is it so important that we remain moral absolutists? How do we grow a stronger confidence in the morality and ethics that are found in the Word of God?
8. Final question. Think of a trying time you went through. In what way did you "Test" the promises of God, and how did you 'prove him o'er and o'er?"
9. Pray a deep prayer of gratitude for God's word. Thank God for the trustworthiness of the Word. Pray a prayer of thanksgiving that the word of God never fails. Commit to trust and believe in God's word.
