"God Is Always There"

(Psalm 119:145-152)

1. Please begin your discussion by going through the NCC (#41). If children are present, please include them too. Remember you can use the book, the phone app or the browser website. Conclude with the prayer together.
2. Read Psalm 119:145-152. What things can you see in this passage that we should be thankful for? Share with the group.
3. Recall together the 3-4 points made in the sermon regarding Christianity's high view of thanksgiving. Of them, which one challenges you the most? Explain.
4. God is near. In what ways do you, by faith, experience the nearness of God? Share a recent example if you have one. Why do you think it is that we don't experience his nearness as often or as deeply as we should?
5. God listens. God promises to listen to us, because we are his children. We became his children through spiritual adoption, when we repented of our sins and trusted in Christ as our savior. This adoption into God's family can never be revoked.

Do you ever wonder if God is really listening to your cries and prayers? How can we be certain beyond a shadow of a doubt, that God always listens to our prayers?

[answers: because we have been adopted. because God promises this in his word. because Jesus experienced separation from God for us]

How can we now approach God even more boldly in our prayers?

6. God saves. God send his Son Jesus into the world to save sinners. What are the implications of this truth for your life as a Christian, especially as you live your life missionally? How does this impact all of your relationships? Spend time prayer for specific people in your life -- that they would cry out, "Lord, save me!"
