
Life Group Sermon Based Questions

"The Word-Lover's Heart" (Psalm 119:161-168) Pastor Peter Yi November 5, 2017

Please begin your discussion by going through the NCC (#45). If children are present, please include them too. Remember you can use the book, the phone app or the browser website. Conclude with the prayer together.

1. Read through today's passage. Select a verse that speaks to you the most. Share why you chose that verse.
2. Look back to this year. We've listened to over 20 sermons on this chapter. How have you changed with regard to the Word? In what way do you love and appreciate it more? In what ways are you interacting with it more deeply? What does your growing love toward the word, or lack thereof, say about your faith?
3. If you've trembled at the Word, it just might be your deepest encounter with it. Share your deepest encounter with the Word, either read on your own or from a sermon. In what way did it make an impact upon you?
4. If we're honest with ourselves, we probably don't rejoice in God's Word and promises? Why do you think this is? What does it say about our attitude toward the Word, and how much we value it? How can you start treasuring it more?
5. "I detest falsehood, but I love your law." Why does the psalmist use such strong language? Do you share similar strong feelings about God as well as things that are against God? Share.
6. What is the secret to obtaining peace? Why is peace almost impossible to attain apart from God's Word?
7. What's the connection between God's omniscience and our obeying his commands?
8. Share any concluding thoughts. Pray for each other, that our love and interaction with the Word will grow.
