### **"To Be Born Again"**

Please begin your discussion by going through the New City Catechism (#12). As the leader, read the question and have the group respond by reading the answer and Scripture together out loud. Then go around the room and read the commentary. If children are present, please include them too. Remember you can use the book, the phone app, or the browser website. Conclude with the prayer together.

1. What parts of Nicodemus' story or life can you relate to?
2. Think of your life when you were a seeker, what similarities are there between you and Nicodemus? If you are a seeker right now, and not yet a Christian, do you see any similarities between where you are at on your faith journey with that of Nicodemus?
3. What about the life and/or teaching of Jesus do you find most compelling?
4. What is unique about Jesus focusing so much of his teaching on his own person?
5. As a Christian do you think you are open to seekers like Nicodemus in your own life? How so and in what way?
6. What does the use of the phrase 'born again' tell us about the nature of Christianity? How does it set Christianity apart from other worldviews?
7. How does it change any misconceptions you might be holding onto about Christianity?
8. What is the connection between the bronze snake in Numbers 21 and Jesus?
9. What are the implications of just looking/just believing in Jesus?
10. What's the one take home application for you from this passage? Share with the group and pray for each other.
