
Life Group Sermon Based Questions

"Jesus, The Bread of Life" (John 6:1-71) Pastor Peter Yi June 3, 2018

Please begin your discussion by going through the New City Catechism (#23). As the leader, read the question and have the group respond by reading the answer and Scripture together out loud. Then go around the room and read the commentary. If children are present, please include them too. Remember you can use the book, the phone app, or the browser website. Conclude with the prayer together.

Hello LG Leaders,

1. Share what God has been teaching you these days in and through his Word? How are you applying it?
2. What were the two purposes of Jesus' signs and miracles? Have these two purposes helped you, daily, to better place your trust in Jesus?
3. Why is it that no one really objects to the miracles of Jesus, but many object to his teaching? What does behaviour tell us about his supposed followers? Is that true today? Is our society against the good deeds of Christians or the teaching of Christians? Why do you think that is? Is there anything we can do about it? [This is an open ended question.]
4. What was the purpose of Jesus testing Philip, even though he was already part of the inner circle of the twelve disciples? What can we learn from this testing for ourselves? In what way might Jesus be testing those of us who consider ourselves Christian?
5. Why did the crowd want to make Jesus king by force?

Why did Jesus choose to withdraw from them and their wishes?

In what way do we try to take Jesus by force? In what way do we try to make him fit into our agenda? How might you be guilty of taking for yourself a Jesus that is unlike the Jesus of the Bible?

6. How does the Gospel -- that Jesus went to die for sinners, that he went to be a suffering servant, a suffering king, enable us to accept him and follow him for who he truly is?
