"The Personal Presence of Jesus"

(John 6:16-21)

Please begin your discussion by going through the New City Catechism (#24). As the leader, read the question and have the group respond by reading the answer and Scripture together out loud. Then go around the room and read the commentary. If children are present, please include them too. Remember you can use the book, the phone app, or the browser website. Conclude with the prayer together.

Hello LG Leaders,

We are near the half way point of the year already and approaching the summer months. I am grateful for you and pray that you will continue to faithfully lead your groups to God through his word.

Here are the questions:

1. What has the Lord been teaching you in your personal devotions this past week?
2. What did the Holy Spirit impress upon your heart as you listened to last week's sermon?
3. We learned that with one group Jesus walked away because they had their own ideas of what it meant for Jesus to be their king. Yet to another group Jesus goes to them, approaches them and quiets their fears and they invite Him into their boat. Share your most vivid experience of Jesus calming your fear. In what way did you experience his personal presence?
4. Think about when you came to Christ. Share with your group the way in which God led you or drew you to Jesus? Theologians call this drawing sovereign grace. Describe how you experienced God's sovereign grace in your own conversion.
5. Spend time thanking God for calling you, choosing you to be saved, and to receive his free gift of salvation. Also, spend time praying that God would choose and call those of our friends and family who are not yet saved. Ask God that he would sovereignly call them to Jesus and they would receive him with open hearts.
